

ANDREW DOCKSEY - MOUNT PLEASANT VILLAGE BOARD TRUSTEE #2 (NP)

Key findings include:

- **Veteran and Incumbent Trustee:** Docksey was first elected to the village board in 2022 and reelected in 2024. He did four overseas tours with the U.S. Army.
- **Republican and Trump Supporter:** Docksey is a Republican, having made several contributions to federal Republicans over the years. While he has not made any statements regarding democracy or elections, he chaired the Racine County GOP in 2024 while the account was mobilizing to elect Trump and was sharing posts undermining election administration.

Mount Pleasant is a village of roughly ~27.7k residents in Racine County, a Milwaukee–Chicago corridor suburb best known for the failed Foxconn development [[NBC Chicago](#), 9/24/2025] and, more recently, large Microsoft data-center investments on former Foxconn-assembled land [[CBS 58](#), 9/24/2025]. Trump took credit for bringing the Foxconn plant to Mount Pleasant initially [[NPR](#), 9/24/2025]. Median household income is around \$90k and the median age is ~45. Ongoing policy context includes the Village’s historic infrastructure/TID build-out for Foxconn, a unanimous 2023 board approval of Microsoft’s expansion, and continuing intergovernmental disputes over water service tied to the Foxconn footprint [[Census Reporter](#), [TMJ 4](#), 9/24/2025].

Politically, Mount Pleasant is extremely competitive. Across all Mount Pleasant ward groups, Donald Trump received carried Mount Pleasant 49.8-48.7 in 2020. Both Evers and Harris ran on similar margins in 2022 (50.29-49.71) and 2024 (50.79-49.21) respectively, losing Mount Pleasant by extremely narrow margins [[Racine County](#), 9/24/2025].

BACKGROUND

Docksey was first elected to the Board in 2022. Landmark Credit Union lists Docksey as a financial consultant (Series 7/66; LPL) and “retired US Army Reserve officer” with >25 years’ service and four overseas tours; U.S. Army reporting places 1st Lt. Andrew Docksey as a PRT civil-affairs officer in Khost, Afghanistan in 2011 [[Landmark CU](#), [Army](#), 9/24/2025].

Docksey is a Republican and chaired the County GOP through the 2024 election cycle. However, it is not clear when start and end dates of his chairmanship were. Docksey has also made many contributions to federal Republicans [[FEC](#), 9/24/2025]. His Facebook features a photo with Trump.

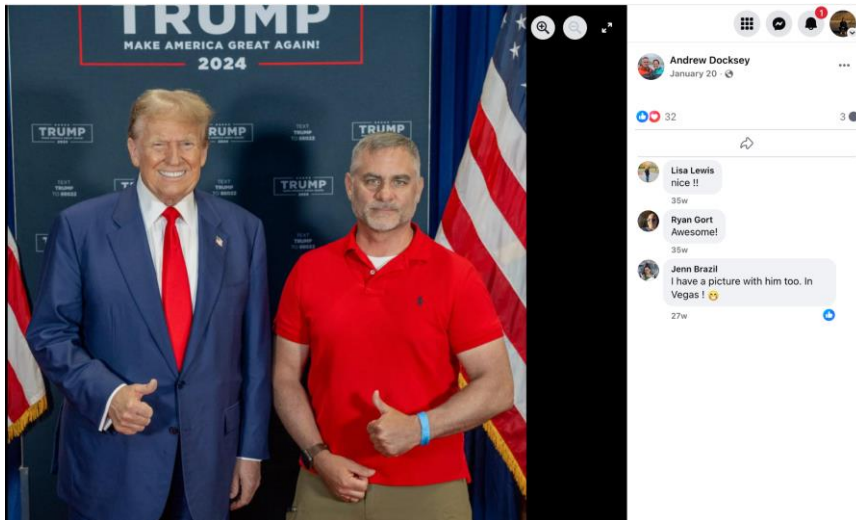
VULNERABILITIES & ADVERSE FINDINGS OF NOTE

CHAIR OF COUNTY GOP THROUGH 2024 ELECTION CYCLE

Docksey chaired the Racine County Republican Party during the 2024 cycle [[Reuters](#), 9/24/2025] and remained listed as the county contact on the county GOP site in 2025, later appearing as an “elected member” on the county GOP board [[Racine GOP](#), 9/24/2025]. During this time the County GOP’s [Facebook page](#) shared election conspiracies, including a November 12, 2024 video from failed Gubernatorial candidate, Eric Hovde, who attempted to sow distrust on Milwaukee County’s election results.

SUPPORT OF TRUMP

Docksey's Facebook has many posts celebrating and supporting Trump. On January 20, 2025, Docksey changed his profile picture to a picture of him and Trump and a patriotic AI photo of the American flag.
