

CATHERINE A. WILSON - GREEN BAY CITY COMMON COUNCIL 10TH DISTRICT

Key findings include:

- **Republican With No Prior Elected Experience:** Wilson has never held elected office or served in city or county government. She has donated to Republican candidates and committees, contributing more than \$500 to the Brown County Republican Party in 2024 and additional GOP-aligned contributions in 2025.
- **Limited Public Profile & Minimal Campaign Infrastructure (so far):** Aside from a sparse campaign Facebook page and personal social media, Wilson has little public-facing policy or campaign materials. Her campaign Facebook bio is generic (public safety, neighborhoods, accountability), with no substantive positions articulated on housing, taxes, infrastructure, or governance issues central to Green Bay politics.
- **Professional Background Outside Politics:** Wilson works as a Business Analyst Consultant at Beacon Technologies and has an academic background in quality systems and organizational development.
- **Significant Online Footprint of Far-Right Rhetoric and Conspiracy Narratives:** Wilson’s X and LinkedIn accounts contain repeated engagement with far-right figures and narratives. Her X includes reposts from Libs of TikTok, references to Dan Bongino (“#BonginoArmy”), other MAGA-aligned accounts, and posts alleging undocumented immigrants voting, ballot trafficking, election manipulation, Islamophobic rhetoric, and other misinformation-adjacent claims.

Brown County, Wisconsin, anchored by the city of Green Bay, has a population of about 268,740 residents according to the 2020 Census. The county is majority white 78.6%, with only 2.4% Black, 4.2% Asian, and 10.8% Hispanic, and a demographic mix of older residents, families, and working-class households [[Census](#), 9/17/2025].

Politically, Brown County sits at the center of northeastern Wisconsin’s swing-state dynamics. Green Bay leans Democratic, while the surrounding suburbs and rural townships trend Republican, making the county highly competitive but slightly Republican-leaning overall. In presidential elections, Brown County has tilted narrowly Republican in recent cycles [[U.S News](#), 10/1/2024]. According to the Brown County Clerk and the Wisconsin Elections Commission, Donald Trump carried the county in 2020 with 52.7 percent of the vote to Joe Biden’s 45.5 percent [[Brown County Clerk](#), 2/22/2024]. Four years later, in 2024, Trump again carried the county with 53.0 percent to Kamala Harris’s 45.5 percent. Turnout rose modestly from about 145,000 ballots cast in 2020 to roughly 150,000 in 2024 [[Brown County Clerk](#), 2/22/2024]. These results underscore Brown County’s role as a bellwether in Wisconsin politics, closely divided but consistently leaning Republican at the presidential level.

Beyond presidential contests, Brown County reflects broader democracy trends in Wisconsin. Local organizations such as *Project VOTE of Brown County* run turnout competitions among municipalities, with villages like Allouez and Wrightstown recording over 90 percent turnout in the November 2024 general election, and Glenmore and Allouez leading turnout in the April 2025 spring election [[Fox News 11](#), 11/14/2024]. Turnout is highly variable depending on the type of election—around 60 percent in spring contests and as low as 17 percent in the June 2025 primary [[The Aberdeen Insider](#), 6/4/2024].

The county has also been at the center of election integrity debates. In April 2025, a federal judge dismissed a lawsuit by two Brown County women challenging the security of Wisconsin's MyVote online voter portal, ruling they lacked standing [[WBAY](#), 4/11/2025]. Additionally, the reinstatement of absentee ballot drop boxes by the Wisconsin Supreme Court in 2024 drew criticism from the Brown County Republican Party, which has emphasized election integrity measures, poll worker recruitment, and ballot security [[WPR](#), 4/5/2024].

Green Bay's 10th City Council District skews Democratic, with an average partisan score of 55.41. Harris won this district in 2024 54-46.

BACKGROUND

PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Little was available online regarding Wilson's personal background online. According to her LinkedIn, Wilson is currently a Business Analyst Consultant at Beacon Technologies Inc.. She has a graduate certificate in Quality Systems from Bowling Green State University and is currently pursuing a doctorate degree in organizational development and change also at Bowling Green State University. She lists volunteer experience as a Big Sister for Big Brother & Big Sisters of America (June 2007 - June 2008) and USF Holland Community Outreach (January 2017 - January 2018).

POLITICAL & CAMPAIGN BACKGROUND

There is no public record of previous elected office. Wilson has not held any prior city or county government position.

Wilson is a Republican, making several contributions to the Brown County Republican Party, totalling over \$500 in 2024 and \$65 in 2025 [[WI Campaign Finance](#)]. She also contributed \$26 to Win Red in 2024, although the candidate was not specified [[FEC](#)]. Further, she regularly shares far-right narratives and conspiracy theories on her X account (more in the vulnerabilities section below).

ON THE ISSUES

Wilson's public profile, aside from her Twitter, is very sparse. She has a campaign Facebook account but so far it only has a profile picture and a simple bio that states "Committed to strengthening District 10 with safer streets, vibrant neighborhoods, and accountable local leadership. With decades of experience in business analysis and community service, I'm focused on practical solutions that work for Green Bay families."

VULNERABILITIES & ADVERSE FINDINGS OF NOTE

SHARED BLUE LIVES MATTER POST ON LINKEDIN

Wilson shared a post from Blue Lives Matter on her LinkedIn relating to the 2024 killing of a state trooper in Illinois. She also reposted a post from Black Rifle Co., whose bio states "Data intelligence and digital for combat/conflict/outdoor industry," a seemingly right-wing account. While the posts themselves are not necessarily controversial, they are definitely indicators of far right leanings.

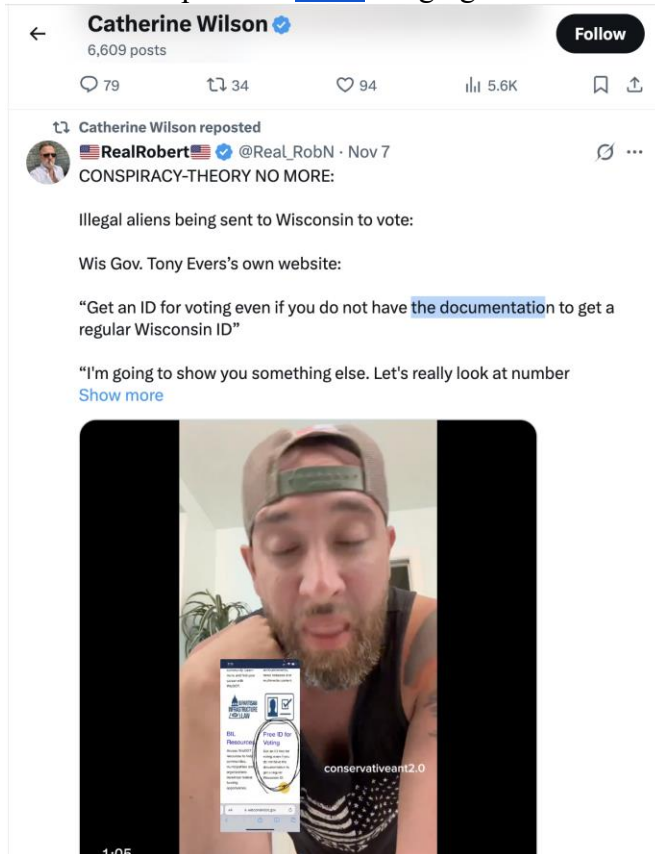

FAR RIGHT NARRATIVES & POSTS ON TWITTER

Wilson regularly expresses far right narratives on her [Twitter profile](#). Her Twitter bio has “#BonginoArmy,” referring to the large, enthusiastic following of conservative media personality and

former Secret Service agent Dan Bongino, encompassing his fans, listeners, and supporters who engage with his podcasts, books, shows (like on NRATV), and news aggregation site The Bongino Report. Bongino’s supporters are often mobilized around right-wing political discourse and support for figures like Donald Trump, with Bongino himself recently appointed as the FBI Deputy Director in early 2025. Her Twitter bio also has the abbreviation “IFBAP,” meaning “I follow back all patriots.” There were many other examples of far right posts on her account. Some examples are below, but Wilson posts frequently so this list is not comprehensive.

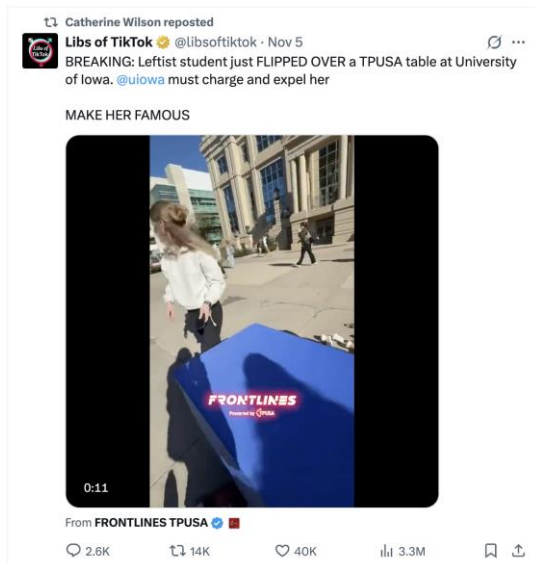
- She reposted a [tweet](#) alleging undocumented immigrants were voting in the 2025 Wisconsin.



- She reposted a response from a far-right account, responding to another far right account, @libsoftiktok, alleging Democrats were carrying around bags of ballots in taxis.



- She reposted a post and video from far-right account, @libsoftiktok, of a student flipping over a TPUSA table in Iowa.



- She reposted a post from JD Vance Republican claiming elections losses in 2025 were not catastrophic and sharing work TPUSA and other groups were doing to change the electorate.

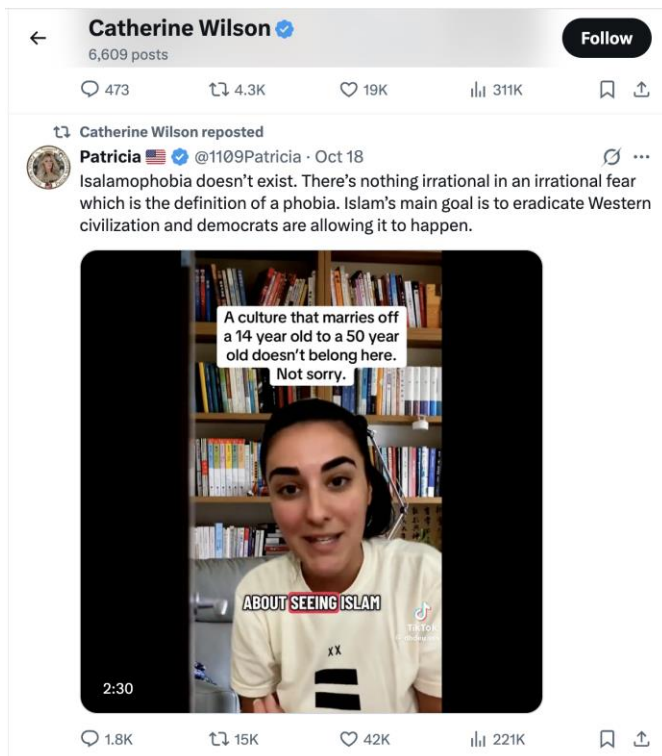
