

DALE STILLMAN - CALEDONIA VILLAGE BOARD TRUSTEE #6 (NP)

Key findings include:

- **Elected in 2018:** Stillman unseated an incumbent in 2018 and was reelected in 2020, beating his opponent by 1,400 votes, and ran unopposed in 2022 and 2024.
- **Donated to Anti-Democratic Republican State Senator:** Stillman made a 2022 contribution to State Sen. Van Wangaard who made unfounded claims of voter fraud in a recount of his 2022 campaign. He also has been a primary driver of an effort to enshrine voter ID laws into Wisconsin's constitution and shared a post relating to Racine voter fraud in 2021.

Caledonia is a suburban/lakeshore village in northeast Racine County (between the City of Racine and Milwaukee County). Population was 25,361 in the 2020 Census; recent ACS estimates put it at ~25.3k with a relatively older median age (~45). Development pressure along the I-94 corridor remains salient (e.g., Ashley Capital's 223-acre South Hills Commerce Center announced in 2025). Caledonia Village is more conservative than the rest of Racine County; Trump won the Village 58-42 in 2024 compared to 53-47 for the rest of the county.

BACKGROUND

Stillman is a decades-long Caledonia resident (listed as 55 years on his village bio). He earned a B.A. in Business from Concordia University and retired after ~30 years with Fiat Chrysler (FCA). He is active in Faithbridge Church in Franksville (trustee; community meals program).

He serves as Trustee #2 on the seven-member Village Board and has been on the board for multiple terms, elected for the first time in 2018 [Caledonia, 9/26/2025]. Stillman won reelection in 2020 by over 1,400 votes and ran unopposed in 2022 and 2024 [Racine, 9/26/2025].

CONTRIBUTION TO REPUBLICAN STATE SEN. WANGAARD

Stillman contributed \$100 to State Rep. Van H. Wangaard in 2022 [[wisdc](#), 9/26/2025]. Wangaard is the State Rep representing Racine County. Wangaard also has made comments about his declared challenger, stating he uses his friendly face to "hide his crazy liberal ideas that are more at home in San Francisco than in Milwaukee and Racine counties. Do not be mistaken – he is every bit an extreme Madison/California liberal as there is. He will vote in lockstep with everything the Democrats stand for – from raising taxes to allowing boys in girls locker rooms" [[Wis Politics](#), 9/26/2025]. Wangaard also made claims of fraud when he lost a recount for his election in 2012 despite no evidence of such fraud [[Badger Herald](#), 9/26/2025]. He also shared a post in October 2021 relating to an investigation into voter fraud in Racine County and has been a vocal proponent of enshrining voter ID laws into Wisconsin's constitution [[WPR](#), 9/26/2025].

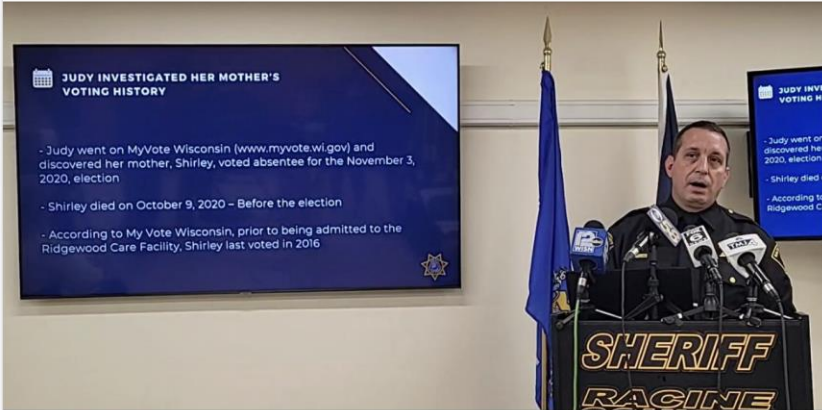
