

LEANNE CRAMER - GREEN BAY CITY COMMON COUNCIL 10TH DISTRICT

Key findings include:

- **Lifelong Wisconsinite:** Cramer is a lifelong Wisconsinite, attending high school one hour north of Green Bay. She moved to Green Bay in 1989 and has a husband and two adult children.
- **Insurance Background:** Despite obtaining a degree in education from the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, she only taught for one year in New Mexico and has worked in insurance in Wisconsin for the past 30+ years.
- **Candidate Experience; Never Held Public Office:** Cramer has never held public office, but she has run for seats in Green Bay and Brown County. She ran for the Green Bay City Council in 2002 and 2004, and the Brown County Council in 2022, losing in the general election for each race. It does not appear as though she had any formal campaign infrastructure or initiatives in any of those prior runs.
- **Republican & Trump Supporter:** Cramer is a Republican; she states that in her personal Facebook bio and has contributed to Republicans since summer 2020. She is an avid supporter of Trump, frequently posting in support of him, his policies, allies, and attacking Democrats and liberals.
- **Radicalized by COVID Restrictions:** Cramer's personal Facebook exhibits extremist, far right, election denier, white supremacist, and hyper-partisan behavior. It seems as though Cramer was radicalized during the COVID pandemic; she rarely posted prior to February 2020 and her posts became increasingly frequent, extreme, and right-wing from around May 2020 to present day.
- **No Formal Campaign & Policy Infrastructure:** Cramer lacks any formal campaign website, social media accounts, or materials. While she has shared some posts indicating policy stances (e.g. anti-immigration, pro-taxes on tips, against overnight parking restrictions, pro-public safety, against data centers), she has not shared anything concrete related to policies she would support or oppose for Green Bay. She did post in support of community policing and downtown development during previous runs for Green Bay City Council.
- **Extreme Posts on Facebook:** Cramer is a frequent poster on her personal Facebook. She posts multiple times daily, mostly on national issues and those relating to politics. She has posted about individuals killed by undocumented citizens, celebrating Trump and his accomplishments as President, and attacking liberals and liberal figures, like Don Lemon.
- **Anti-Diversity, Anti-Somali Immigrants, & Minnesota Fraud:** Recently Cramer has posted on stories emerging from Minnesota around Somali immigrants and allegations of fraud. She has posted attacking Somali immigrants, highlighting allegations of fraud, crime, and mass migration. She also attacked Green Bay Mayor Eric Genrich for supporting the Somali community in Green Bay in the face of racist attacks.
- **Support & Defender of ICE:** Cramer frequently posts in support of ICE and deportation efforts. She has been very vocal in defending ICE's actions in relation to the shooting in Minneapolis and attacking Renee Good for her actions.

- **Anti-Democracy Rhetoric & Actions:** In the aftermath of the 2020 election, Cramer posted frequently sharing conspiracy theories relating to the 2020 election and advocating for congress to overturn the election results. She also took action, joining an ethics complaint against Green Bay Mayor Eric Genrich in relation to his acceptance of election administration grants.
- **Anti-Vaccine:** Cramer shared a post that quotes RFK saying the chicken pox vaccine causes Shingles outbreaks. Cramer celebrated the fact she did not vaccinate her kids against chicken pox.
- **Called for Violence Against Woman:** Cramer shared of a news story where a woman allegedly strangled an 11 month old child in a daycare. Cramer posted “suffocate her!” when sharing the article.

Brown County, Wisconsin, anchored by the city of Green Bay, has a population of about 268,740 residents according to the 2020 Census. The county is majority white 78.6%, with only 2.4% Black, 4.2% Asian, and 10.8% Hispanic, and a demographic mix of older residents, families, and working-class households [[Census](#), 9/17/2025].

Politically, Brown County sits at the center of northeastern Wisconsin’s swing-state dynamics. Green Bay leans Democratic, while the surrounding suburbs and rural townships trend Republican, making the county highly competitive but slightly Republican-leaning overall. In presidential elections, Brown County has tilted narrowly Republican in recent cycles [[U.S News](#), 10/1/2024]. According to the Brown County Clerk and the Wisconsin Elections Commission, Donald Trump carried the county in 2020 with 52.7 percent of the vote to Joe Biden’s 45.5 percent [[Brown County Clerk](#), 2/22/2024]. Four years later, in 2024, Trump again carried the county with 53.0 percent to Kamala Harris’s 45.5 percent. Turnout rose modestly from about 145,000 ballots cast in 2020 to roughly 150,000 in 2024 [[Brown County Clerk](#), 2/22/2024]. These results underscore Brown County’s role as a bellwether in Wisconsin politics, closely divided but consistently leaning Republican at the presidential level.

Beyond presidential contests, Brown County reflects broader democracy trends in Wisconsin. Local organizations such as *Project VOTE of Brown County* run turnout competitions among municipalities, with villages like Allouez and Wrightstown recording over 90 percent turnout in the November 2024 general election, and Glenmore and Allouez leading turnout in the April 2025 spring election [[Fox News 11](#), 11/14/2024]. Turnout is highly variable depending on the type of election—around 60 percent in spring contests and as low as 17 percent in the June 2025 primary [[The Aberdeen Insider](#), 6/4/2024].

The county has also been at the center of election integrity debates. In April 2025, a federal judge dismissed a lawsuit by two Brown County women challenging the security of Wisconsin’s MyVote online voter portal, ruling they lacked standing [[WBAY](#), 4/11/2025]. Additionally, the reinstatement of absentee ballot drop boxes by the Wisconsin Supreme Court in 2024 drew criticism from the Brown County Republican Party, which has emphasized election integrity measures, poll worker recruitment, and ballot security [[WPR](#), 4/5/2024].

Green Bay’s 10th City Council District skews Democratic, with an average partisan score of 55.41. Harris won this district in 2024 54-46.

BACKGROUND

PERSONAL BACKGROUND

Cramer grew up in Wisconsin, graduating from Marinette High School in Marinette, WI (about 1 hour north of Green Bay). She has a husband and two adult children.

Cramer is a graduate of the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, graduating in 1988 and earning her bachelor degree in education. Cramer is a provider representative at Humana where she has worked for 32 years. Before Humana, she worked as a Claims Processor at Midwest Security Administrators from 1990-1994 and as a first grade teacher in Shiprock, NM for one year from 1988-1989. Cramer has lived in Green Bay since 1989 [Green Bay Press-Gazette, 4/27/2018].

In 2002, Cramer stated she is a volunteer at The Salvation Army and at Trinity Lutheran Church [Green Bay Press-Gazette, published 2/3/2002].

Cramer's personal Facebook exhibits extremist, far right, election denier, white supremacist, and hyper-partisan behavior. It seems as though Cramer was radicalized during the COVID pandemic; she rarely posted prior to February 2020 and her posts became increasingly frequent, extreme, and right-wing from around May 2020 to present day. While she did share some mainstream conservative posts from prior to 2020, they were far less extreme than the posts she has shared over the past six years. she also only started contributing to republicans in 2020, indicating another step towards her radicalization and to action.

POLITICAL & CAMPAIGN BACKGROUND

Cramer has not held public office before, but she previously sought offices in Green Bay and Brown County. According to a candidate profile, Cramer ran for Green Bay City Council twice in the early 2000s [Green Bay Press Gazette, published 1/26/2022]. Her 2002 and 2004 runs seemed to be very similar in terms of a low campaign presence and focusing on priorities in Green Bay:

In 2002, Cramer stated she wanted to make Green Bay a place “where people are proud to say where they live. That means increasing home ownership and making area residents more aware of their responsibilities. We just have to have more contact and have people be more aware of their surroundings. I take pride in my own home and I take pride in my neighborhood and I want to get that across to other people to start to take pride in where they're living.”

She sought a Brown County Board seat (District 7) in 2022, losing in the general election to the incumbent by a 62-37 margin [[TCH Daily News](#)]. It does not appear Cramer ran a particularly active campaign in 2022.

Cramer has been active in local controversies – notably pushing for in-person schooling during COVID and questioning election practices. Local media have identified her with election-denialist circles: the *Green Bay Press-Gazette* and watchdog outlets described Cramer as one of the few area candidates “espousing the Big Lie” about 2020 election fraud. She also joined an ethics complaint against Mayor Genrich over the 2020 election grant [[Bolts Mag](#), [Bolts Mag](#)].

Cramer was also a passionate voice during the COVID restrictions in 2020, frequently posting against in-person restrictions, mask mandates, and virtual schooling. Aside from opposition to COVID restrictions and election denier policy, Cramer has not outlined specific issue-areas or a policy agenda for her 2026 candidacy and, similar, she did not for her 2022 run for Brown County Board.

Cramer is a Republican, having made small contributions to Win Red since June 2020. The bio on her [personal Facebook](#) also reads “A True Republican!” While her campaign infrastructure for her 2026 run so far is sparse, her personal Facebook is very active, frequently posting conspiracy theories, memes, attacks against Democrats, and support of Trump from conservative media organizations. Cramer shared conservative Green Bay alder, Jennifer Grant's, post announcing she had campaign signs.

ON THE ISSUES

OPPOSITION TO COVID RESTRICTIONS

Throughout 2020 during the COVID pandemic, Cramer publicly opposed school closures and mask mandates. In December 2020 she joined a parent protest demanding all Green Bay schools reopen immediately, saying “If they don’t open the schools back up... parents are going to say... I’m pulling my kids from [Green Bay schools] and I’m putting them in a different school district” [Fox 11].

Cramer opposed masks, citing her difficulty breathing and the constitution; “Cramer opposed the idea of mask mandates, stating, ‘There’s a reason laws were put on the books. It goes back to the Constitution.’ Cramer said wearing a mask hampers her ability to breathe, a point often made by those who oppose mask mandates” [Green Bay Press-Gazette, 1/29/2022].

TAXES ON TIPS

While Cramer did not take a specific stand on the issue, she did share a post of the passage of a Wisconsin “no taxes on tips” Bill which, while having some bipartisan support, saw 30 Democrats vote against it.



AGAINST OVERNIGHT PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Cramer is quoted in an April 2018 article relating to Green Bay overnight parking restrictions (parking not allowed on city streets from 3am - 5am). Cramer stated in the article that her “home has a small garage and a driveway, which she said is not large enough to hold all the vehicles for herself, her husband and two children. ‘I’ve been pushing my daughter back on buying a car. I’m like, where would we stick it? It’s unfortunate that somebody can’t have that freedom to drive a vehicle because we don’t have the opportunity to put it somewhere.’” [Green Bay Press-Gazette, 4/27/2018].

As an elderly citizen experienced in large corporations and education, with some knowledge of people, I believe those early years are best developed in the home by loving parents. The emotional development and all-important moral guidelines from a good home are more critical than outside schooling.

PUBLIC SAFETY

During her 2002 and 2004 run for Green Bay City Council, Cramer touched on public safety and crime:

- Cramer and her opponent in 2002 both pointed to rising gang activity in the city and say they'd like to work more with the city's police department to curb such problems [Green Bay Press-Gazette, published 2/3/2002]. She lost the 2002 race by just 20 votes. She lost by 66 votes in 2004.
- Cramer expressed support for the city's then community policing program [Green Bay Press-Gazette, 3/20/2004]. To revitalize the city's downtown, Cramer argued for looking to Ashwaubenon to find out what their "secret sauce" is for attracting businesses [Green Bay Press-Gazette, published 4/3/2004].

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT & REVITALIZATION

Cramer stated downtown revitalization and development should still be a priority for the city, claiming the most important projects were the Washington Commons, former Boston Store building and Broadway [Green Bay Press-Gazette, 3/10/2002]. Her final priority in 2004 was listed as keeping "the city spending in line with the budget" [3/21/2002].

AGAINST DATA CENTERS

Cramer shared a post asking people to contact their officials if the potential redevelopment of a UW campus was for an AI data center because data centers are bad for the environment.

ANTI-DEMOCRACY RHETORIC & ACTION AFTER 2020 ELECTION

In a 2022 candidate forum, Cramer stated she is “disappointed that the Wisconsin Supreme Court allowed (remote) ballot boxes. People who had gloves on, so they wouldn't leave fingerprints, were dumping ballots (in with ballots cast by actual voters). I said this in the forum and I almost got shot down. We need to fix 2020.” [Green Bay Press Gazette, published 2/13/2022]. In 2021 she joined an ethics complaint attacking the mayor over accepting election administration grants.

Cramer has also posted many memes sharing election and anti-democratic conspiracy theories and even going so far as to advocate for members of congress to challenge the electoral college results.

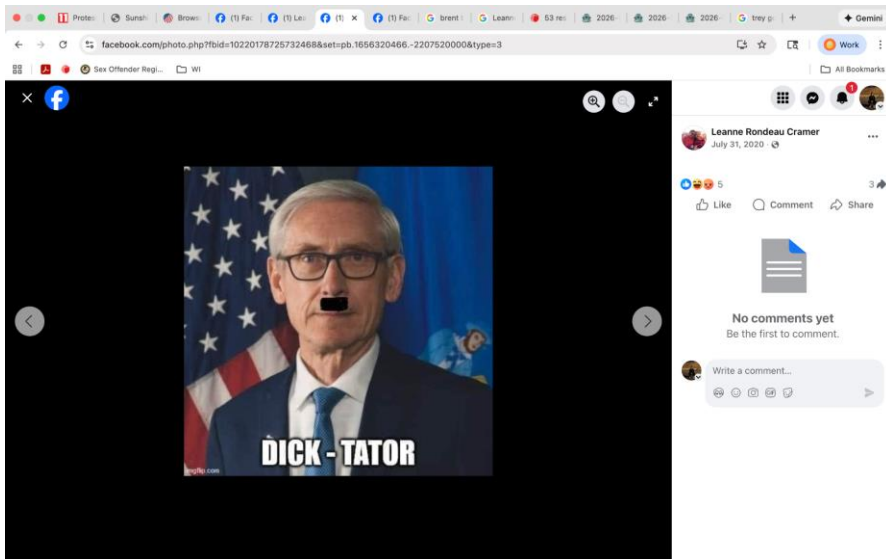


CALLED TO DEFUND WELFARE

Cramer shared a post from MAGA Nation claiming she'd rather be an American than a Democrat.



On January 21, 2026, Cramer shared a post relating to the killing of two North Carolina college students by a drunk driver. The post states “ICE put a detainer on” the driver, which could be why Cramer shared the post. Cramer shared a similar post on January 12, 2026, from [The Conservative Read](#) that details an undocumented immigrant who killed a couple while driving while intoxicated.

The Republican Party of Brown County

Cramer shared a post from a far right journalist's Instagram account that claimed to find 60 empty "home healthcare" offices in one Minnesota City building. The post claims ""There is layer upon layer upon layer of fraud in this city." And there's no way the state didn't know." The post is from [Brittany M. Hughes](#), a right wing influencer and podcaster for the Media Research Center. The Media Research Center is a media and media watchdog organization, founded by Brent Bozell. Bozell was appointed to be the CEO of the U.S. Agency for Global Media which oversees the Voice of America network, the government-funded international broadcasting network founded in 1942 to fight Nazi disinformation [[Politico](#)].

Cramer shared a post claiming a Tim Walz appointee murdered the only lawmaker who tried to stop the fraud in Minnesota, stoking conspiracy theories.

The killer, who murdered two Minnesota lawmakers in summer 2025, was appointed by Governor Walz in 2019 to serve on Governor's Workforce Development Board. The murderer appears to be mentally unstable, claiming that he "was trained by U.S. Military people off the books starting in college" and that he has "been on projects since that time in Eastern Europe, North America, the Middle East, and Africa." He claimed "'Recently I was approached about a project that Tim Walz wanted done, and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Keith was also aware of the project," the letter stated. "Tim wanted me to kill Amy Klobushar and Tina [REDACTED]. Tim wants to be a senator and he doesn't trust [REDACTED] to retire as planned and thinks she is going to stay on at the last minute" [[KATU](#)].
