

PETER STOLL- BROOKFIELD CITY COMMON COUNCIL DISTRICT 1

Key findings include:

- **Prior Electoral Performance:** Stoll previously ran for Brookfield Common Council District 1 in 2022 and lost..
- **Ideological Orientation:** Stoll has explicitly branded himself as “the conservative choice,” placing his candidacy clearly on the ideological right in a formally nonpartisan municipal race.
- **Public Rhetoric & Tone:** Through his campaign social media, Stoll used dismissive language toward elected officials, including referring to members of the Milwaukee County Board as “idiots,” which could raise concerns about temperament and professionalism.
- **Culture-War and Inflammatory Facebook Comments:** On his campaign Facebook page, Stoll has posted transphobic culture-war commentary, including stating that “men cannot get pregnant.” He also commented on the January 2026 fatal ICE shooting in Minneapolis, saying the incident was “tragic” but that he stands with law enforcement and found the Minneapolis mayor’s response “reprehensible.”

Brookfield is a suburban city in Waukesha County in the Milwaukee metro area, generally characterized as a wealthier suburb in regional coverage. Brookfield had a population of 41,464 as of the 2020 census. Demographically, Brookfield is majority white with a notable Asian population share.

Brookfield has been one of the primary municipalities involved in the debate over absentee ballot drop boxes. Brookfield’s City Council voted to ban the use of absentee ballot drop boxes in August 2024. A complaint was filed against the City of Brookfield with the Wisconsin Elections Commission in September 2024 alleging that the city refused to accept any absentee ballots at polling places and instead required them to be returned to the clerk’s office with enough time for the clerk to bring the ballot to the correct polling place to be counted. The man who brought the complaint alleges that when he arrived at the polling place around 5 p.m. he was told he must bring his ballot to the clerk’s office but that no one would be there to receive it because city staff was in a meeting [[Urban Milwaukee](#)]. Further, some Brookfield Republican politicians are election deniers, like Scott Fitzgerald (R), whose political base includes the Brookfield area, was among those who voted against certifying 2020 results for certain states on Jan. 6, 2021 [[Election Deniers](#)].

BACKGROUND

Peter Stoll is a Brookfield, Wisconsin resident since 2007 and a candidate for Brookfield Common Council (Alderman), District 1, which includes Wards 1–3 of the city. Stoll previously ran for the same seat in the 2022 Brookfield spring election and lost to incumbent alderperson William Carnell [[Journal Sentinel](#), 4/5/2022]. On his public social media profiles, Stoll lists his occupation as a digital creator and identifies as politically conservative, framing his candidacy within that ideological orientation [[Facebook](#), accessed, 2/5/2026].

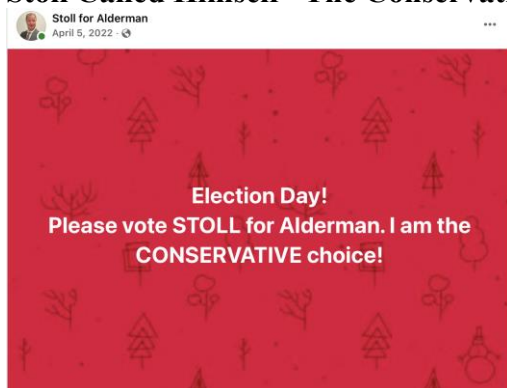
