

RED ARNOLD - KENOSHA CITY COMMON COUNCIL 6TH DISTRICT (R)

Key findings include:

- **Perennial candidate with repeated losses:** Arnold has run for state legislative office multiple times since 2013 and has never won a race, including two general election losses to Chris Larson and a GOP primary loss in 2022. His current municipal candidacy follows a decade-long pattern of unsuccessful statewide runs.
- **Residency/messaging mismatch:** Arnold’s personal social media and campaign website heavily reference South Milwaukee and Milwaukee County and do not meaningfully reference Kenosha. This creates a potential vulnerability around local rootedness and district focus.
- **State/national ideological campaign for a municipal office:** His issue platform centers on Obamacare, constitutional amendments, DOT reform, immigration, gun laws, and national culture-war framing, with little Kenosha-specific municipal policy. Opponents could argue he is running a nationalized ideological campaign rather than focusing on local governance.
- **Public praise of far-right and polarizing figures:** Arnold explicitly listed admiration for figures including Stefan Molyneux, Lauren Southern, David Clarke, Mark Belling, Duke Pesta, Scott Walker, and Donald Trump. Several of these individuals are widely associated with inflammatory rhetoric, extremism-adjacent media ecosystems, or major public controversies.
- **Documented tie to a “dark money” advocacy lawsuit:** Arnold was named in federal litigation brought by Citizens for Responsible Government Advocates seeking to allow corporate-funded groups to coordinate issue advocacy with candidates. He filed a declaration supporting the lawsuit. This creates a clear, documented link to campaign-finance transparency controversies.
- **Pattern of combative, culture-war rhetoric:** His education, immigration, gun, and climate statements use highly ideological language (e.g., “educators with God complexes,” assimilation requirements, climate skepticism framed against “environmental warriors”). This rhetoric could alienate moderate municipal voters.
- **Social media ecosystem risk:** His campaign social accounts frequently amplify memes, conspiracy-adjacent content, and far-right influencer material rather than local policy. Posts include voter-fraud claims, anti-BLM content, anti-vaccine/FDA conspiracy framing, and culture-war messaging.
- **Campaign finance optics:** Past filings show a late report in 2016 and small-dollar expenditures at fast food and retail stores, which, while legal if documented properly, can raise optics questions about campaign discipline and professionalism.
- **Ideological rigidity over pragmatism:** His messaging repeatedly emphasizes distrust of experts, absolutist framing (“1 test is worth 1000 expert opinions”), and moral certainty. This posture may signal governance style concerns in a collaborative municipal setting.
- **Extensive culture-war positioning:** Anti-abortion stance, strong pro-gun constitutional carry advocacy, immigration assimilation criteria, anti-CRT framing, climate skepticism, and anti-

Obamacare messaging place him firmly in a national hard-right ideological lane uncommon for local council races.

Kenosha is a mid-sized city on Lake Michigan with 98,000–100,000 residents, a median age near 38, and 42,000 households. The population is diversifying: 62.8% White (non-Hispanic), 10.3% Black (non-Hispanic), and 19.7% Hispanic/Latino, with smaller Asian and multiracial shares [[Census](#), 9/26/2025]. The city maintains an industrial base and increasingly functions as a commuter hub between Milwaukee and Chicago.

Politically, the City of Kenosha leans Democratic, while Kenosha County has trended more competitive/right. The county, long Democratic at the presidential level, shifted right in the Trump era and remains a battleground. At the local level, a GOP-backed majority captured the officially nonpartisan County Board in 2022 and subsequently repealed weapons restrictions in county buildings and adopted a “Second Amendment sanctuary” stance [[Kenosha County](#), 9/26/2025] [[Wisconsin Examiner](#), 4/2/2024]. The political climate has also featured election-denial rhetoric: in May 2022 a county supervisor hosted an “election integrity” event in Kenosha that local media described as promoting debunked 2020 claims; around the same period, then-Mayor John Antaramian was subpoenaed in Michael Gableman’s election investigation, which he criticized as a waste of public resources [[Wis Politics](#), 9/26/2025].

Federal context—2020 and 2024. In 2024, Donald Trump carried Kenosha County (official county results show Trump 52% to Biden 46% in the county), even as Joe Biden narrowly won Wisconsin statewide, underscoring the county’s rightward tilt relative to the state. In 2024, U.S. Rep. Bryan Steil won re-election in WI-01, which includes Kenosha, reflecting continued GOP strength in the district; statewide, Sen. Tammy Baldwin won re-election, demonstrating ongoing split-ticket dynamics [[WPR](#), 11/5/2024]. Kenosha County’s official 2024 results are posted by the clerk (including the Nov. 5 general), and the Wisconsin Elections Commission certified statewide 2024 results at the end of November [[Kenosha County](#), 9/26/2025].

Harris won this district in 2024 53.5-46.5.

BACKGROUND

PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

In his campaign biography, Arnold describes being born and raised in Milwaukee, coming from a family of educators (both parents), and later attending UW–Parkside (after starting at Carroll College). His campaign bio references a wife named Julie and describes personal experiences including past alcohol addiction and long-term sobriety (framed as informing his views on addiction and policy) [[Vote Arnold](#)].

Arnold’s personal Facebook still lists him residing in South Milwaukee. Further, his campaign website heavily mentions South Milwaukee and Milwaukee County but does not at all mention Kenosha County.

His Statement of Economic Interest discloses ownership interests in two LLCs, described in the filing as operating in areas such as graphics/web design and e-commerce (the entity names appear handwritten/partially unclear in the scan) [[Kenosha](#)].

CAMPAIGN & POLITICAL BACKGROUND

Arnold has frequently run for office in Wisconsin but has never secured a victory.

- **2013 Special Election for Wisconsin Assembly:** Arnold ran in the 2013 Republican primary for a Wisconsin Assembly special election (District 21) and was defeated.
- **2014:** Arnold ran for Wisconsin State Senate District 7 in 2014 as a Republican, losing 60-40 to Democrat Chris Larson.
- **2018:** Arnold ran again for Wisconsin State Senate District 7 in 2018 as a Republican, losing again to Democrat Chris Larson 66-34.
- **2022:** Arnold ran again for Wisconsin State Senate District 7 in 2024 as a Republican, losing to Republican Peter Gilbert in the Republican primary 54-45.
- **2026:** Arnold is running for Wisconsin State Senate District 7 in 2026 as a Republican. The Republican primary is in August [[Ballotpedia](#)].

In a 2018 Ballotpedia questionnaire, Arnold emphasized themes like serving “the people,” opposing “special interest groups,” and government “failure equat[ing] to more money.” Arnold also listed figures he admires, including Donald Trump, Sheriff David Clarke, Stefan Molyneux, Lauren Southern, and Duke Pesta, among others, explaining that he values that they “stand up for what is right” despite opposition [[Ballotpedia](#)].

His campaign issues page uses combative ideological framing in several places (e.g., climate-policy skepticism framed around “environmental warriors,” and strong cultural/identity framing around immigration). He also thanks members of the U.S. military for their service, including a letter addressed directly to them on his [campaign website](#).

Arnold’s issue content repeatedly emphasizes tax cuts and skepticism toward tax/gas-tax increases, and frames transportation policy around DOT reform and cost-cutting through “data driven analysis” (Six Sigma language). However, the policy examples he uses (e.g., “DOT reform,” “no gas tax increase”) are oriented toward state government, not city public works budgeting [[Vote Arnold](#)].

EDUCATION

Arnold argues the U.S. has fallen behind other countries in education due to their focus on non-educational issues, like CRT and ignoring of reading, STEM, writing, and arithmetic.

“I suggest returning to basics which includes holding students AND parents alike, accountable to not only themselves but to the rest of society they claim to want to better. On the flip side we not only need to make Universal School Choice available to all families, regardless of income, we also need to implement a Parental Bill Of Rights to protect the rights of parents from these educators with God complexes. There’s a reason that liberals don’t need to have children... they have yours by way of the schools” [\[Red Arnold\]](#).

AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION (ARTICLE 5)

Arnold argues he should be elected because he has the character to make decisions on amending the constitution.

“I am well aware that this may open up a can of worms but if everyone is ignoring a stop sign then your only hope to save lives is to build a bigger and more visible stop sign. Sometimes the only logical choice is to be illogical, like the events that unfolded in the Star Trek episode; The Galileo Seven. If the Federal Government ever got too powerful, the Founding Fathers put Article V into the Constitution so that the States had a say in their fate. If this is indeed needed to right our listing constitutional ship then there will need to be men and women of character in the various state legislatures who will do what is right and bring this to fruition. Sometimes doing what is right means not worrying about your next election. Character is doing the right thing when no one is watching” [\[Red Arnold\]](#).

TAXES

Arnold argues for using data driven analysis and techniques to cut unnecessary and wasteful spending rather than raising taxes to fix budget shortfalls.

“The only thing certain in life are death and taxes. Taxes are necessary; Roads, schools, water, sewer, snow plowing, police, fire departments, parks, defense, etc. However taxes are to be used like food, as a necessity, not for pleasure or filling voids. We cannot continue to take the easy way out by simply taxing to the hilt in order to correct sloppy mistakes. If the Department of Transportation has a budget shortfall, toll roads and gas taxes are not the answer. The answer is to use Six Sigma and data driven analysis and techniques to cut unnecessary and wasteful spending. The government can’t give you anything it doesn’t first take from someone else” [\[Red Arnold\]](#).

DRUGS

Arnold shared a long and winding rant on his campaign website with sparse policy recommendations relating to drug policy and drug use.

Some drugs need to be decriminalized and others need harsher sentences. As of this writing, half the states in the union have realized this. When prisons are becoming so crowded that private sector prisons (who love more inmates to bolster the bottom line) are being built without question we need to reconsider some of these decades’ old pieces of legislation. No drug is without side effects whether its aspirin or heroin, but we need to look at the logical and empirical statistics when we make decisions on this. We need to refrain from allowing propaganda, stereotypes and emotional reasoning to cloud our judgement. Most importantly we need to knock the chair out from under this game that keep the government large and looming. The Colorado/Washington/west coast experiment will have to be

watched with great interest. Do we want to be one of the last states to let truth, logic & freedom prevail like we had to do with Concealed Carry? You can't legislate morality [[Red Arnold](#)].

VULNERABILITIES & ADVERSE FINDINGS OF NOTE

PRAISES FAR RIGHT FIGURES

In a Ballotpedia survey for his 2018 run for congress, Arnold listed conservative and far right figures he looks up to.

“Nassim Hamein, Kirk Sorensen, Sheriff David Clarke, Donald Trump, Leah Vukmir, Scott Walker, Stefan Molyneux, Mark Belling, (& all the 1130AM hosts really), Dr. Duke Pesta, Lauren Southern, Kathleen Zellner: Why? Because they stand up for what is right no matter what the opposition does or says. They do what's right because they know they're right, regardless of the so called ""experts"" say. 1 test is worth 1000 expert opinions. ""Be sure you are right - then go ahead. ~” [[Ballotpedia](#)].

A few examples from the controversial people he praises:

1. **David Clarke, Former Milwaukee County Sheriff:** Clarke has been covered as facing lawsuits/complaints related to deaths at Milwaukee County Jail and has a long record of incendiary public statements (e.g., against BLM) [[WPR](#), [Washington Post](#), [Fox 6 Now](#)].
2. **Leah Vukmir, Former Wisconsin State Assembly Member & Senate Candidate :** Vukmir is documented as a WI GOP legislator and U.S. Senate nominee, and ALEC's own materials present her as a senior legislative figure (with broader reporting tying her to ALEC leadership) [[Sourcewatch](#)].
3. **Scott Walker, Former WI Governor:** Walker's signature legislation Act 10 restricted collective bargaining and drove major statewide protests and long-running political conflict.
4. **Stefan Molyneux, Far Right Influencer:** Research and reporting describe Molyneux as a far-right radicalizing figure; he is covered in the context of YouTube hate-speech enforcement and far-right ecosystem analysis [[Gnet Research](#), [The Guardian](#), [Wikipedia](#)].
5. **Mark Belling (and “the 1130 AM hosts”):** Belling has long-running controversy history including on-air use of an ethnic slur during a segment about “potential voter fraud” and related suspensions/criticism [[Chron](#), [Trib Live](#), [On Milwaukee](#)].
6. **Dr. James “Duke” Pesta, UW Oshkosh Associate English Professor:** Reporting describes lawsuits and campus controversies around Pesta, and a legal-news account describes a case involving termination/discipline issues tied to research misconduct findings and a racially charged paper [[Advance Titan](#), [Bloomberg Law](#), [Advance Titan](#)].
7. **Lauren Southern, Far Right Activist:** Reuters reported UK authorities (border police in Calais) denied her entry and described her as a right-wing activist; she has been widely covered in connection with far-right activism [[Reuters](#), [Independent](#), [Wikipedia](#)].

TIE TO CITIZENS FOR RESPONSIBLE GOVERNMENT

In 2014, while running for Wisconsin State Senate, Jason “Red” Arnold was identified in federal litigation filed by Citizens for Responsible Government Advocates (CRG) as one of the candidates the group sought to collaborate with on a “Take Charge Wisconsin” website and related issue-advocacy communications. In the same case docket, a “Declaration of Jason Arnold” was filed as part of CRG's injunction motion practice. CRG's complaint stated the group accepts corporate contributions and asserted it was not subject to Wisconsin committee registration/disclosure requirements while challenging state restrictions on coordinated issue advocacy.

CRG in Wisconsin is typically referenced as Citizens for Responsible Government (Milwaukee-area conservative advocacy/activist org) and affiliated entities, including Citizens for Responsible Government Advocates, Inc. (a 501(c)(4)).

CRG was a key outside player in the early-2000s Milwaukee County pension scandal environment and launched a recall drive against then-County Executive Tom Ament (timeline coverage) — often cited as part of the political chain of events leading to Scott Walker’s rise [[Milwaukee Journal Sentinel](#), [Milwaukee Magazine](#)]. For example, Milwaukee Journal Sentinel coverage in 2009 described CRG advocating for/defending Walker’s Milwaukee County budget and pushing for vetoes [[Milwaukee Journal Sentinel](#)].

In CRG’s 2014 federal complaint, CRG says it accepts corporate contributions and is not subject to Wisconsin’s committee registration/disclosure requirements, while seeking to collaborate with candidates on issue advocacy [[U.S. District Court](#)]. CRG’s filing describes the possibility of broadcast advertising that could be narrated by or feature the candidate-collaborators (including Arnold). Campaign-finance watchdogs/advocacy orgs treated the case as significant enough to file amicus briefs opposing CRG’s effort to enjoin coordination restrictions [[Campaign Legal Center](#)].

CRG’s complaint names “Jason ‘Red’ Arnold” and describes him as a 2014 Wisconsin Senate candidate, stating that collaboration with him was “central” to CRG’s planned “Take Charge Wisconsin” project [[U.S. District Court](#)]. The federal docket for Citizens for Responsible Government Advocates Inc. v. Barland lists “Declaration of Jason Arnold” filed as an exhibit supporting CRG’s motion practice—i.e., he wasn’t just mentioned; he was a supporting declarant in the case record [[Justia](#)].

NATIONAL, STATE, AND SOUTH MILWAUKEE MESSAGE FOR MUNICIPAL OFFICE
Arnold’s campaign materials, particularly his [website](#), emphasize state and national issues, including healthcare, second amendment rights, Wisconsin Department of Transportation reform, education, and immigration. Other issues, like taxes and jobs, are not talked about in a local sense for Kenosha but rather seen through a state and national lens.

His campaign website also frequently mentions South Milwaukee and Milwaukee County but does not mention Kenosha at all.

CAMPAIGN MEME ACCOUNT

Arnold keeps an active campaign [Facebook](#) and [X](#) account, but both frequently share and engage with memes, conspiracy theories, and far right/conservative influencers rather than policy or local news.

LATE CAMPAIGN FINANCE STATEMENT IN 2016

Wisconsin Ethics Commission meeting materials from 2016 include “Vote Red Arnold” in a listing of late-filed reports (shown as 4 days late for a report entry) [[WI Ethics](#)].

USED CAMPAIGN FUNDS FOR BURGER KING, SPEEDWAY, SPIRIT HALLOWEEN

Arnold’s reported campaign expenses include small dollar amounts used for Burger King, Speedway, Spirit Halloween, Ace Hardware, and Menards, [[WI Campaign Finance](#)].

IMMIGRATION

Arnold expresses conservative views on immigration, including “Speak the language” and “No handouts.” He goes on to say “If you have a child on American soil then you have to follow those criteria within a certain time frame or you cannot stay, plain and simple.”

“Every American who is not Native American is an immigrant. The great melting pot of the world is such because of its cultural diversity. I celebrate my heritage as much as the next person but I am an American, first and foremost. I pledge allegiance to the flag and I obey American laws. America came to greatness because we pitch in from all backgrounds and walks of life. There is a process in place to become an American citizen and it must be followed. If it needs to be amended in order to conform to the modern world then let’s do so. If someone wants to become an American it should be a... span. As in spanning a bridge to connect each other. S.P.A.N. — S: Speak the language P: Pay taxes. A: Assimilate (pledge allegiance to America and swear to uphold the Constitution and its values) N: No handouts. That’s it. Easy as can be. Having a child on American soil will no longer be “Automatic”, it will have to be “Earned” just like everything else of value in life. If you have a child on American soil then you have to follow those criteria within a certain time frame or you cannot stay, plain and simple. If you can do those few but necessary things and constructively add to the great melting pot of the world, then... welcome to America my friend” [[Red Arnold](#)].

PRO-SECOND AMENDMENT

Arnold on his campaign website claimed “Gun control, just like prohibition, makes criminals out of law abiding citizens.”

“Guns merely make it easier to commit certain crimes. The world will never be rid of guns, nor violent people. Taking means of defense away from the innocent does not prevent tragedy, if anything it increases it. We have gun laws on the books. Perhaps we should begin enforcing the ones we have before making new ones. A law without a penalty is merely advice. Making good people helpless won’t make bad people harmless. We need to pass a Constitutional Carry Law & perhaps even more importantly, a Stand Your Ground Law” [[Red Arnold](#)].

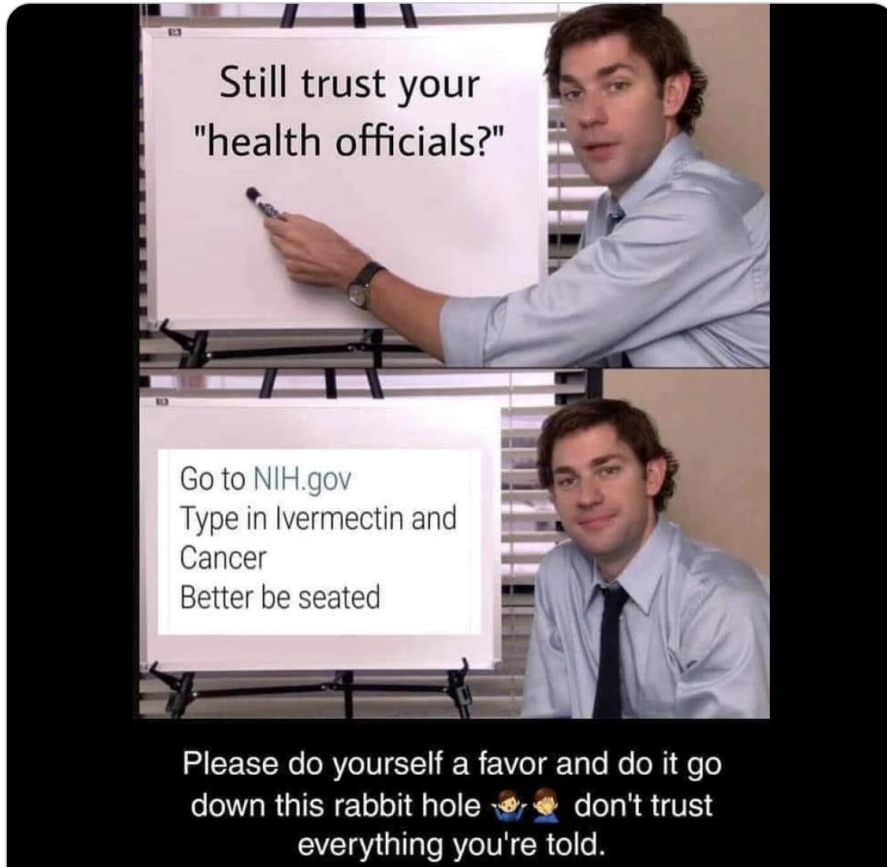

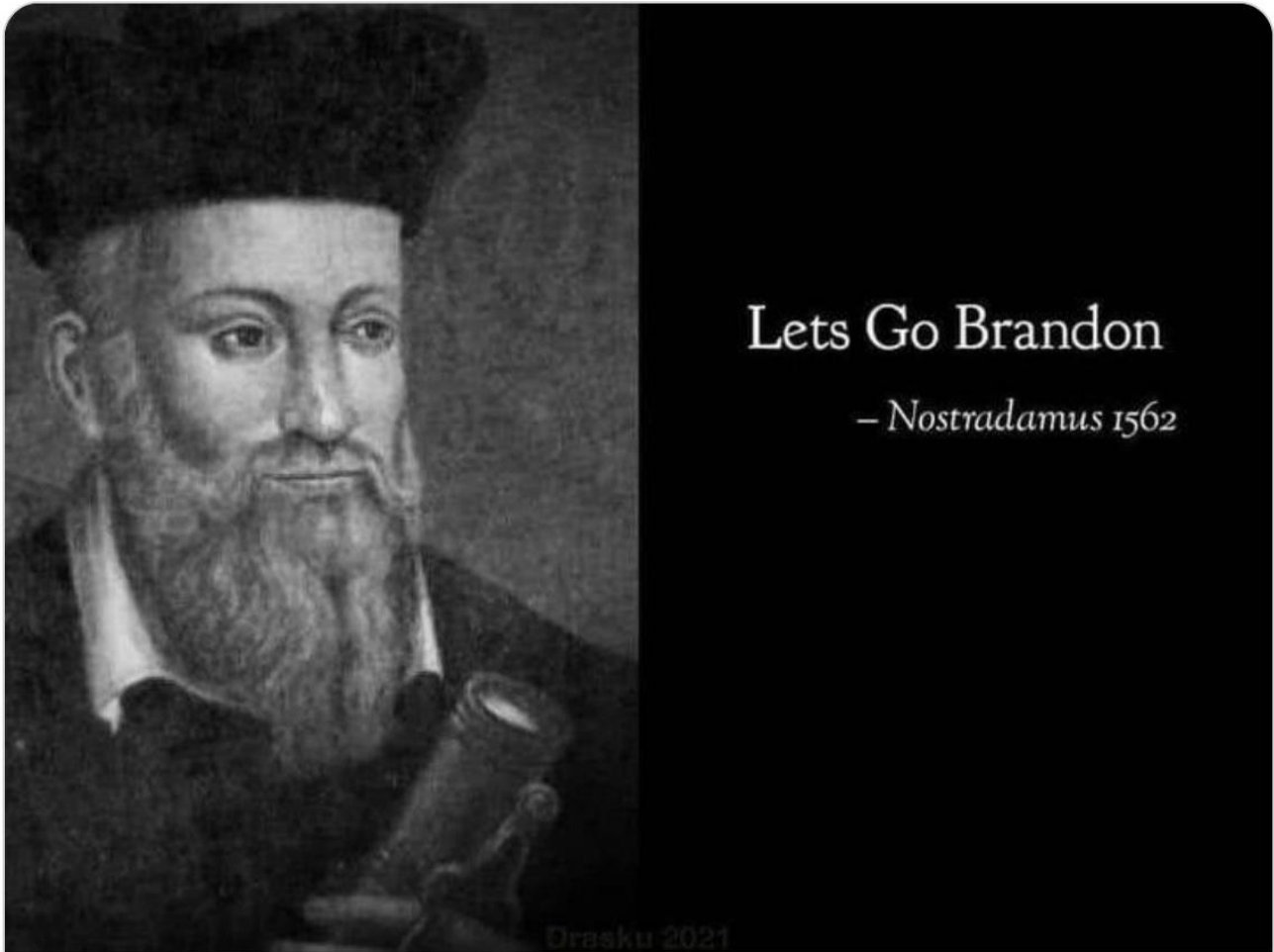

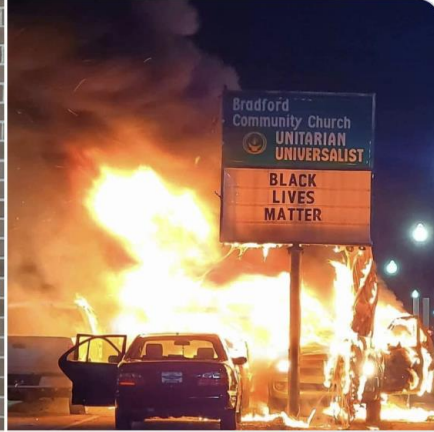
