

## **RENEE HILL - WYOMING CITY COUNCIL AT-LARGE (NP)**

Key findings include:

- **First-Term City Councilor:** Hill was elected to the Wyoming City Council 2022.
- **Republican:** Hill is a Republican, having won a precinct delegate position in 2022. She also made contributions to Trump’s PACs in 2020 in the immediate aftermath of the election. She also donated to an election denier state candidate and to Unlock Michigan, a 2020 ballot measure pushed by Republicans.
- **Muted Online Presence:** Hill has a very muted online presence, with very little campaign or personal activity found.

Wyoming is a working-class, majority-suburban city of ~77,452 in Kent County, contiguous with Grand Rapids. Kent County, historically Republican, has been competitive-to-blue at the top of the ticket lately. In 2024, Democrats carried the county for president (53-47).

Democracy has been a salient local theme: Mayor Kent Vanderwood (a former councilmember) was charged in 2023 in Michigan’s “fake electors” case and later publicly reacted when a judge dismissed charges against most defendants in September 2025 [[ABC 13](#), 10/24/2025].

### **BACKGROUND**

Renee Hill was elected Council Member-at-Large on Nov. 8, 2022, finishing first with 12,045 votes (38.7%) in a three-candidate field for two at-large seats [Kent County, 10/24/2025]. Hill is a doctor of physical therapy who provides home-care services and has lived in Wyoming for 27+ years. Before her election she served on the city’s Community Enrichment Commission (appointed June 21, 2021) [[WKTV Journal](#), 10/24/2025].

Hill is a Republican, having donated many times to Republicans federally and at the state and local level [FEC, MI BOE, 10/24/2025]. She also was elected Republican precinct delegate in 2022 [Kent County, 10/24/2025].

#### **CONTRIBUTIONS TO TRUMP PAC**

Hill donated more than \$200 to Trump PACs in November and December 2020, immediately following the election [[FEC](#), 10/24/2025].

#### **CONTRIBUTIONS TO ELECTION DENIERS/FAR RIGHT CAUSES**

Hill made over \$1,000 to Kevin Green’s 2021 bid for a State Senate seat in Michigan. Green advocated for a forensic audit of the 2020 election. She also contributed to Unlock Michigan, a 2020 ballot measure in Michigan intended to curtail the powers of Governor Whitmer [[MI BOE](#), 10/24/2025]. Her contributions to Green (all after August 11) occurred well after the primary (August 3). Green called for a recount following his narrow loss, citing “potential concerns” [[MLive](#), 10/24/2025].
