

## **STACI LINDBERG - LYON COUNTY CLERK/TREASURER (R)**

Key findings include:

- **Republican County Clerk:** Lindberg is the Republican County Clerk/Treasurer for Lyon County. She was elected for the first time in 2022, coming from the private sector. Lindberg won handedly in the general election in this conservative county but she won an extremely narrow three-way Republican primary. One of her opponents in the primary, the second place finisher, Lisa Glass, did not appear then to be an election denier or to support extreme voting laws.
- **Election Denier:** Lindberg is an election denier and Trump-supporter. She shared posts from Trump-supporting meme accounts on her personal Facebook. Further, she shared election misinformation and claimed she supported policies that would remove fraud from the elections in Nevada.

Lyon County is a relatively small, rural county with 63,700 residents. It is located just east of Washoe County. The county seat is Yerington and the largest city is Fernley. Fast-growing Dayton and Silver Springs among key unincorporated areas.

Lyon is heavily conservative with Catherine Cortez Masto losing the county 26-69. Like many other Nevada counties, Lyon has also been impacted by many election conspiracies, including pushes for the hand counting of ballots.

### **BACKGROUND**

Lindberg describes herself as a third-generation lifetime Lyon County resident, raised on a dairy/alfalfa farm near Yerington (the Silva family) [[Pizen Switch Times](#), 10/8/2025]. Reported 37 years in the private sector across several fields before entering public office, which she has highlighted as preparation for the Clerk-Treasurer administrative role [[Fernley Reporter](#), 10/9/2025].

Lindberg was elected for the first time in 2022. She won the general election 74-26 over her non-partisan opponent in 2024. In contrast, in the primary, she won by only 65 votes over fellow Republican Lisa Glass. She was also only 185 votes ahead of third place Elaine St. John.

Limited research showed Glass likely was not an election denier, opposing hand counting and calling it a waste of taxpayer money. She emphasized Lyon's elections are safe and secure [[Fernley Reporter](#), 10/9/2025]. St. John on the other hand. St. John centered her campaign on "election integrity," said "Voters have lost confidence in computer voting," vowed to "push for paper ballots," conduct spot audits, 24-hour surveillance of ballot drop boxes, and touted involvement with the Election Integrity Project Nevada (a group that litigated against Nevada's mail-ballot expansion in 2020). These are hallmark positions of the post-2020 election-denial movement in NV [[The Fernley Reporter](#), 10/9/2025]. Further research would be needed to back up these claims and ensure they are still current on those individuals.

Lindberg is a Republican. She spoke at a Fernley Republican Women meeting in April 2023 [[Fernley Reporter](#), 10/9/2025].

### **ON THE ISSUES**

#### **HAND COUNTING OF BALLOTS**

While hand counting ballots has come up as a topic in Lyon County, Lindberg was not the clerk when it was raised as a possibility. Therefore, there were not public statements from her relating to the hand counting of ballots.

## **VULNERABILITIES & ADVERSE FINDINGS OF NOTE**

### **BALLOT ERROR 2024 PRIMARY**

Misprinted instructions told voters to select the wrong number of candidates in two local races (Fernley Ward 5; Stagecoach GID). A judge ordered a special election in July 2024. Lindberg called it a misunderstanding of nonpartisan primary rules, pledged it “will never happen again,” and said her office would institute additional DA/legal review and consult other clerks [[Fox Reno](#), 10/9/2025].

### **REDISTRICTING ERROR 2024 GENERAL**

A portion of Precinct 26 was left in the wrong Assembly District after 2021 redistricting; discovered Nov. 1, 2024. The SOS and county concluded no change could be implemented before polls closed; county issued public guidance [[Lyon County, KOLO 8](#), 10/9/2025].

### **OPTED OUT OF STATE ELECTION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN 2024**

Lindberg said all registered voters in Lyon County will receive new registration cards due to the implementation of Nevada’s new top-down Voter Registration & Election Management System. However, Lyon County opted out of a state program that offered to mail a signature update form to voters, as the form required private information on a postcard, which Lindberg said could compromise voter privacy. Lindberg advised voters to disregard SOS signature-update instructions mistakenly included in a mailing produced by the state’s print vendor.

### **FACEBOOK POSTS**

Lindberg’s personal Facebook had some posts that were supportive of Trump, Charlie Kirk, and others from right-wing meme accounts.

A post relating to her candidacy from May 2022 had many controversial claims regarding policy that was needed to rid elections of fraud. “How we can protect your vote and stop fraud in our elections. Some address this as a local official issue, but in fact it is a governing issue and can only be fixed by legislation. We must work at the State level to cancel automatic voter registration, mandatory mail in ballots and institute automatic voter roll purge processes.”
