

NORTH CAROLINA DISTRICT COURT JUDGE CANDIDATE LLOYD WILLIAMS **DISTRICT 2 SEAT 2 (R)**

Key findings include:

- **Contentious primary election.** During the primary election, Williams had to address “mud slinging” that he claims his primary opponent was engaged in. His opponent was accusing him of being a “Trojan Horse Democrat” also known as a “RINO” (Republican in Name Only). [[Facebook](#), 2/22/2026]

JURISDICTION SUMMARY

North Carolina’s District Court District 2 covers a largely rural region in eastern North Carolina, including counties such as Beaufort, Hyde, Martin, Washington, and Tyrrell. These counties are part of the Inner Coastal Plain, characterized by small towns, agricultural economies, and relatively low population density. Politically, the region tends to lean conservative at the local and state level, with Republican candidates often competitive or dominant in judicial and county-level races.

Demographically, the area includes a mix of white and Black populations, with pockets of economic hardship and limited access to services compared to urban areas. Judicial races here are often low-information contests, meaning name recognition, local ties, and professional reputation (especially within the legal community) can carry significant weight.

BACKGROUND

Lloyd Lee Williams III is an Assistant District Attorney and currently serves as the Lead Prosecutor for the Recovery Treatment Court, a role focused on handling cases involving substance abuse and rehabilitation-oriented justice. He has also served as President of the Second Judicial District Bar, indicating a degree of leadership and recognition within the local legal community [[Lloyd Williams](#), accessed 3/29/2026] Williams holds a bachelor’s degree from East Carolina University (2000) and a law degree from Campbell University (2004). He was born and raised in Hyde County and maintains strong local ties, including involvement in a local Baptist church [[Ballotopedia](#), accessed 3/29/2026] Professionally, his background is entirely within the prosecutorial sphere, suggesting a law-and-order orientation typical of career prosecutors.

Williams has donated \$7,840.36 in NC state contributions, primarily to his own campaign but has no federal campaign contributions.

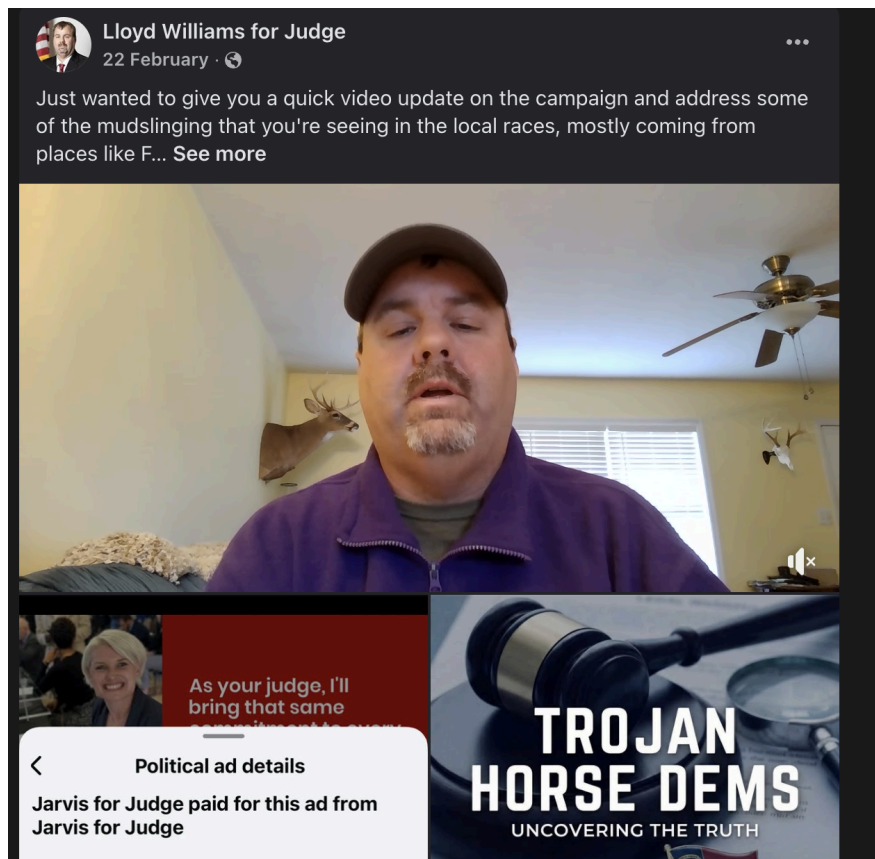
