Key Findings Include:

- **Has Supported Both Democrats And Republicans For Office.** Smith has repeatedly stated that he did not want to be tied to either political party as he claims his focus is “on something far greater.” While he donated to Barack Obama’s 2008 campaign and to then-Michigan Senator Debbie Stabenow in 2021 and endorsed Hillary Clinton in 2016, his most recent campaign contributions have all been to Republican candidates. In September of 2020, Smith said he was still undecided on whether he would support President Trump.
- **Donated \$1,000 To The Republican Candidate For Secretary Of State Who Claims Noncitizens Voting Is “A Problem In The System.”** In July 2026, Smith donated \$1,000 to Anothony Forlini, the Republican candidate for secretary of state. Forlini has said noncitizen voting was the result of ‘a problem in the system.’ Forlini has also falsely accused a citizen of being a noncitizen and illegally voting.
- **Has Had A Series Of Financial Troubles Including An August 2026 Foreclosure On His Home And An Earlier Chapter 7 Bankruptcy.** Over the past three decades, Smith had more than a dozen judgements and liens against him including chapter 7 bankruptcy. Notably, Smith faced an August 2026 foreclosure on his home. While the foreclosure was adjudicated, Smith’s mortgagee was Republican State Senator John Bizon. In February 2022, Bizon pled guilty to misdemeanor assault and battery charge against a nurse.
- **Had Made Questionable Statements Regarding His Racial Identity.** Smith has described himself as a “non-colored guy” and reportedly as a religious man who happens to be Black. Smith said that he has received pushback and said, “my peers say that I forget where I came from.”

Jurisdiction Summary

Battle Creek is located in southwest Michigan. The City Commission is a nonpartisan body. In 2024, Trump won Calhoun County with 57.11% of the vote to Harris's 48.89%, a difference of 9,618 votes but Harris won Battle Creek 54%-46%. Battle Creek has a population of 52,731.

The mayor serves a two year term with elections held during midterm elections. Battle Creek only began directly electing its mayor in 2020. Incumbent Mayor Mark Behnke (R) ran unopposed in 2024 but did not garner more than 50% of the vote in either 2020 or 2022.

'I called the state of Michigan and said 'I want to know what I have to do to start a driver's ed school,'" Smith said. 'I had to do a nine-month course and drove to Muskegon two days a week to do that.' The majority of his driver's ed students are from Battle Creek, Harper Creek, Lakeview, and Hastings. Smith Previously Served As A Calhoun County Commissioner In The Late 1980s. “Long before Kingdom Builders came into being, Smith was working for positive change in the community. Before he moved south, he served as a Calhoun County Commissioner in the late 1980’s and worked for Washington Heights Community Ministry where he wrote grants and created job development opportunities under the leadership of Rev Clifton V. Bullock. He is a lifelong member of the NAACP (National Association for the Advancement of Colored People).” [Second Wave Media, [12/17/20](#)]

Smith Said He “Practices Some Of The Similar Values That Keep Family Structures Strong” As Conservatives. “Economic independence is important for Bishop Tino Smith, who runs Kingdom Builders Worldwide ministries in Battle Creek. Smith identifies as an Independent but said he often supports conservative Republican politicians because he agrees with their policies. ‘I don’t agree with the conservative of keeping things the way they were, because we’ve got to change.  - **February 2022: Bizon Pled Guilty To A Misdemeanor Assault And Battery Charge For Assaulting A Nurse.** “State Sen. John Bizon (R-Battle Creek), facing a misdemeanor assault and battery charge stemming from a medical visit in August, entered a guilty plea Thursday in Calhoun County. [...] On Aug. 14, Bizon was ill with COVID-19 and visited the Oaklawn Medical Group to seek treatment. He and a female nurse practitioner were discussing medications when Bizon allegedly “‘intentionally grabbed her with his right arm/hand, by her waist, pulled her into his body, squeezed her hip with his right hand, and told her he is an otolaryngologist,’” according to the police report. Afterward, Bizon grew ‘visibly angry’ when the nurse declined to order a specific medication for him. The medication he sought was reportedly not meant to treat his diagnosis. Bizon also allegedly grabbed a medical assistant’s arm and told her, ‘my blood pressure is up’ because she was in the room.” [Michigan Advance, [2/18/22](#)]
