Key Findings Include:

Erickson Told A 2022 Candidate Forum "So My Level Of Confidence In Machines Is Not There," After The County's Own Election Administrator Had Already Refuted The Premise. He described being given shifting answers: "I'm not technical enough to know whether

the machines were hackable, but what we're told when asked is, 'They're not connected online.' When pressed on that, 'OK, they're connected online, but they're not hackable.' Then when pressed on that, they say, 'Well, they are hackable, but there's no evidence of fraud.'"

Administrative Services Director Deborah Erickson said the county does not connect its voting machines "to anything at all" and is "more restrictive than the law." He also said secretaries of state throughout the country "exceeded their purview in setting policy for the way votes were counted." The county board he seeks to join oversees election administration [Brainerd Dispatch, 9/21/2022].

Erickson Shared Turning Point USA's AmericaFest 2021, A Conference Built Around 2020 Election Denial. TPUSA ran a panel titled "State By State Election Integrity: What Happened In AZ, The Audit, And The Future" — "The Audit" being the Cyber Ninjas review of Maricopa County — and Phoenix New Times reported that Turning Point "has played a key role over the past year in disseminating claims of election fraud on a national level – and in Arizona" [Phoenix New Times, 12/20/2021]. Kyle Rittenhouse was the marquee guest one month after his acquittal and received a standing ovation [Newsweek, 12/21/2021]. Arizona Mirror documented a white nationalist in attendance and a January 6 participant who was given press credentials [Arizona Mirror, 12/23/2021].

Erickson Has Repeatedly Promoted Election Deniers And MAGA Figures On His Personal Facebook. He posted praising Kari Lake — "Kari Lake is great. Poise level: EXPERT. She also happens to be right" — shared an article quoting Michael Flynn titled "We Are in the Midst of a Fascist Power Grab, But We the People Still Have Options," and shared an American Mind piece titled "The War Against Woke Communism" [Tad Alan Erickson, 3/13/2026].

Erickson Voted For A 9.54% Preliminary Levy Increase And Then For The Final Increase. "Johnson, Bevans, Tiffany Stenglein, Jamie Bieser and Tad Erickson voted in favor of the 9.54% preliminary increase," driven by former firefighters "who were granted a total settlement of \$3.9 million due to unfair labor practices when the council voted to dissolve the full-time fire department and its union" [Brainerd Dispatch, 9/20/2022]. The council certified a 3% increase in December, "but property taxes for many are still expected to rise because of a significant overall increase in property values throughout the county" [Brainerd Dispatch, 12/21/2022]. He was present and the levy and budget passed unanimously with no dissent noted [Brainerd City Council Meeting Minutes, 12/19/2022]. His 2026 platform leads with maintaining low property taxes [2026 Lakes Area Voting Guide, accessed 9/1/2026].

Erickson Named Health And Human Services As The County Budget Area He Would Cut, While Conceding It Is "An Increasing Need." "The county has a \$100 million budget, 42% of that ... comes from the property taxes. And I think we have to find other ways to bring those taxes down and cut costs, particularly in the area of health and human services, even though

that's an increasing need," he said. "And don't get me wrong, there's certain needs there as well" [Brainerd Dispatch, 9/21/2022].

Erickson Voted For A Roughly 50-Megawatt Crypto Mining Operation And Told Commissioners It Was Not Their Place To Question The Applicant's Business Plan. He was one of three Planning Commission members supporting VCV Digital's interim use permits in September 2022. "Erickson, who sits on both the Planning Commission and City Council, advocated for the permits, telling commissioners it was not their place to question the business plan of someone proposing to do business in the city. The business, he said, is the one taking the risk upon themselves" [Brainerd Dispatch, 10/07/2022].

Erickson Is Running His Third Campaign In Four Years And Filed Fifteen Months Into The Four-Year Term He Won In 2024. He served on the council 2019–2022, declined to seek re-election in order to run for county board, lost to Barrows, won a Ward 1 term in 2024, then announced for county board on March 20, 2026. Ward 1 voters face a second mid-term departure in four years from the same person [Brainerd Dispatch, 3/20/2026].

Erickson Is A Republican Who Contributed To Trump Save America In A Formally Nonpartisan Race. His one federal contribution went through WinRed earmarked for the Trump Save America Joint Fundraising Committee in April 2023 [FEC, accessed 9/2/2026]. He has no Minnesota state or local contributions [Minnesota Campaign Finance Board, accessed 9/2/2026].

Erickson Campaigns On The Sheriff's 287(g) Agreement With Federal Immigration Authorities But Was Absent From The Council Vote On It. His campaign video, filmed outside the county jail, states: "I want to state clearly my unapologetic support for law-enforcement, first responders, and emergency service workers." The video description says he "demonstrates his commitment and support for Law Enforcement even in the face of opposition to the Sheriff Office's 287G agreement with Federal authorities" [Commissioner Tad Erickson, 08/26/2026]. The Brainerd City Council passed a resolution supporting the sheriff's agreement in July 2025; Erickson was absent from that meeting [Brainerd Dispatch, 07/17/2026].

Erickson Said The Pandemic Response "Overstepped" And Infringed On Individual Rights. "I feel like we've taken the scientific process and used that to infringe on individual rights and individual freedoms. And so I think — I'm not saying we shouldn't do any of that, but I'm saying I think it overstepped...I think the decision-making would have been better handled on the local level than how it was" [Brainerd Dispatch, 7/19/2022].

The Crow Wing District 3 Seat Is Open. Two-Term Incumbent Steve Barrows Announced In April 2026 That He Would Not Seek A Third Term. Barrows won the seat in 2018 and 2022 after roughly. [Brainerd Dispatch, [4/16/2026](#)]

Though The Office Is Nonpartisan, Crow Wing County Leans Strongly Republican. In 2022 Scott Jensen carried the county over Gov. Tim Walz 61.82% to 34.87% and Jim Schultz carried it over Attorney General Keith Ellison 66.81% to 33.13% [Brainerd Dispatch, [11/12/2022](#)].

Erickson Announced His Candidacy For County Board On March 20, 2026, Fifteen Months Into His Four-Year Term He Won in 2024. Erickson also declined to run for a second term after the expiration of his partial term in 2022, instead running for County Commission. Ward 1 voters are facing a second mid-term departure in four years from the same person. [Brainerd Dispatch, [3/20/2026](#)]

CAMPAIGN BACKGROUND

Erickson's 2026 Lakes Area Voting Guide Questionnaire Lists Three Top Priorities: Maintaining Low Property Taxes, Ensuring Public Safety, And Commitment To Land And Water Resources Stewardship. Under taxes he pledges to “Support pro-growth policies that broaden the counties tax base,” “Identify innovative solutions to reduce county expenditures when possible,” and “Relieve businesses from unnecessary overregulation.” Under public safety the first sub-point is “By NOT defunding the Sheriffs Office.” Under stewardship: “Protecting Water Quality,” “Prudent Land-Use Decisions,” and “Prioritizing Solid-Waste and Forestry Practices” [2026 Lakes Area Voting Guide, [accessed 9/1/2026](#)].

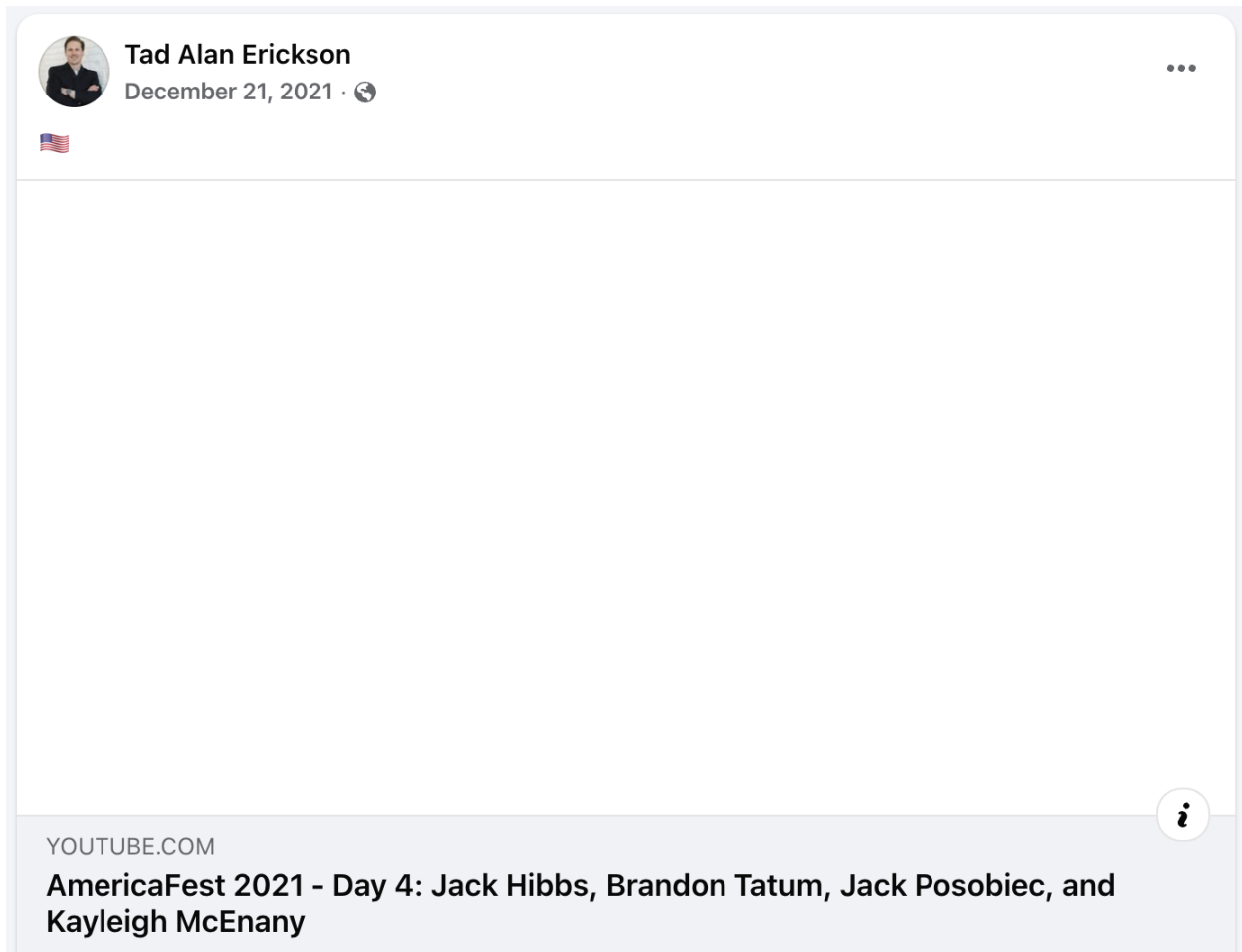

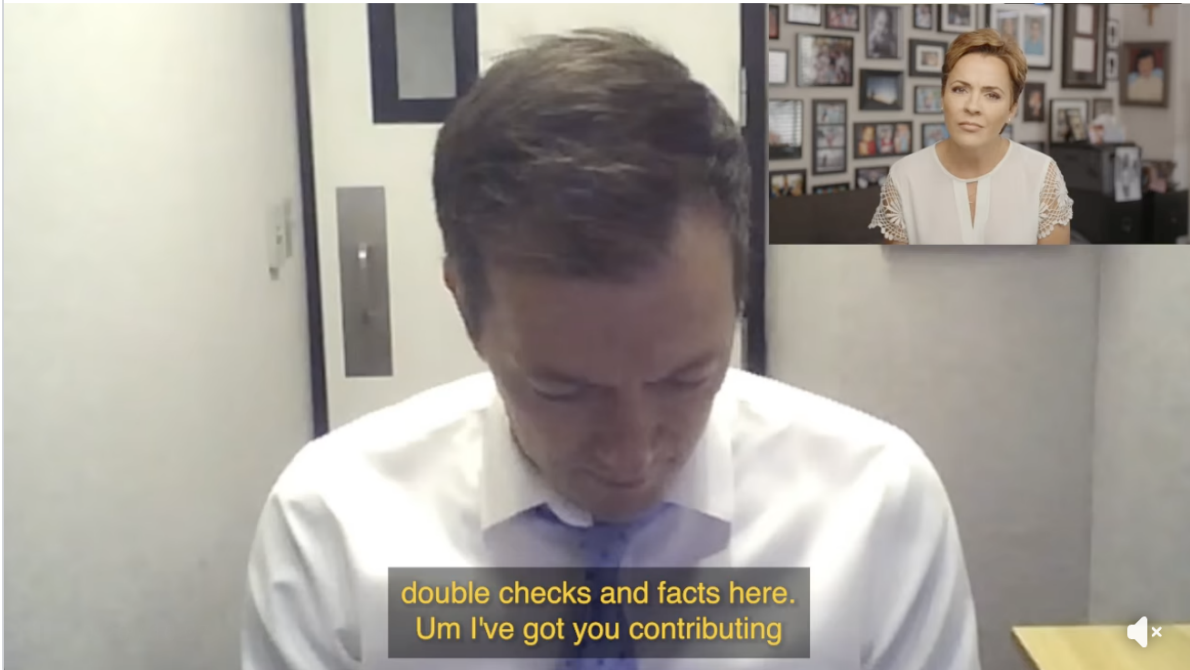

The council ultimately certified a 3% increase in December, “but property taxes for many are still expected to rise because of a significant overall increase in property values throughout the county” [Brainerd Dispatch, [12/21/2022](#)]. Erickson was present at the city council meeting when the levy and budget were voted upon. No dissent was noted on the vote, so the budget and levy increase passed the Brainerd City Council unanimously on December 19, 2022 [Brainerd City Council Meeting Minutes, [12/19/2022](#)].

The Planning Commission recommended denial 3-2; Chair Don Gorham said, "I just don't see any hard information coming from the applicants right now about what the operation is going to do" [Brainerd Dispatch, [5/17/2024](#)].

The Council Formalized Its Denial 6-1, Citing 25 Megawatts Of Consumption For Only 16 Jobs, 24/7 Operation, And Nighttime Sound That Could Exceed Minnesota's 50-Decibel Residential Standard. PUBLIC RECORDS

Erickson Was Cited For Driving 70 In A Posted 60 Zone On Highway 371 In Crow Wing County In February 2020, Five Months After Joining The Brainerd City Council. The citation was filed in district court on February 6, 2020 as case 18-VB-20-543, with the Crow Wing County Attorney as prosecuting agency. The single charge under Minn. Stat. § 169.14.4 is a petty misdemeanor, which under Minnesota law does not constitute a crime and carries a maximum \$300 fine; the record notes it was not a third violation, and no accident damage. Erickson was convicted and fined \$125.00 [Minnesota Judicial Branch Minnesota Court Records Online (MCRO), accessed 9/2/2026].
